## *Process*

Guided by *CFWP* Affinity Groups that are organized by issue/topic, *CFWP* members will conduct research aimed at providing data for effective solution and funding brainstorming.

Possible Affinity Groups may include Economic Empowerment, Health & Wellness, Violence & Crime among others.

## *Membership*

We welcome women interested in promoting the mission of the *Center for Women's Philanthropy*. We strive to attract a membership that is diverse and inclusive.

Each CFWP member contributes a minimum of \$1,000 annually for a minimum of three years. Of that annual amount, \$700 (70%) goes into the funding pool for grant making, \$200 (20%) goes to build the endowment and \$100 (10%) to cover administrative costs. Gifts to the *Center for Women's Philanthropy* are tax deductible.
